Awana clubs are “*life-enriching*” experiences for children that emphasize strong moral and spiritual values to help them in their daily lives. Overall, clubbers learn about **God**, the **Bible**, and **respect** for our nation.

Parents are always welcome to club and even play games with your children. Remember to dress casual and wear tennis shoes.

WHAT HAPPENS AT AWANA?

We open with a flag ceremony and prayer, meet in small groups with their leaders for HANDBOOK time and exciting, team-oriented GAME COMPETITION.

The **HANDBOOKS** are for achievement-oriented learning, emphasizing the importance of God’s Word for sound living.

Clubbers progress through graded handbooks. Parents are encouraged to assist their children in learning at least **one section** each week from their handbooks. We would love to have kids do 2-3 sections that are ready to share with their Awana leaders.

Leaders will listen to the memorized sections your children learn through the week each Wednesday night. Please show interest in your child’s achievements — and help them work at home on their Awana books.

All groups then come together for **COUNCIL TIME** — we use this time to teach the truths of the Bible. The evening closes with a presentation of awards recognizing individual clubbers who have passed sections in their handbooks. Awards are proudly displayed on their uniforms. Please help put their patches on their uniforms.
